So accordingly, in one month a Professorial Unit should generate '**746,851.53**' Work Units to qualify as a teaching Surgical Unit.

This Professorial Unit has generated '**615,432.47**' Work Units during the evaluation period **May 01, 2008 to May 31, 2008**.

So , as such it is short of '17.60 %' or by '131,419.06' Work Units that is not fulfilling the requirement to be qualified as Teaching Unit.

So , as such it is short of '52.42 %' or by '391,496.62' Work Units that is not fulfilling the requirement to be qualified as Teaching Unit.
